### **BACKGROUND**

The American Institute of Architects is the voice of the architecture profession. AIA is dedicated to serving its Members, advancing their value and improving the quality of the built environment. It is the largest and most influential professional association for architects, interns and those directly involved in the practice of architecture.

For over 100 years AIA New Jersey has been serving New Jersey architects and the public. Its mission is to “serve the public’s needs and build awareness of architects and the profession through education and advocacy”.

In 1896, the Society of New Jersey Architects was formed. A few years later in 1900 this society was disbanded when a chapter was granted to New Jersey by The American Institute of Architects (AIA). For many years during the beginning conducted business side by side, the New Jersey Chapter of the American Institute of Architects and The New Jersey Society of Architects. The society and chapter merged in July, 1965, and the name was officially changed to the New Jersey Society of Architects of the American Institute of Architects.

Today AIA New Jersey continues to be a state chapter and region of the national AIA. In 2000 the AIA-NJ chapter celebrated its 100th anniversary. The chapter is divided into six local sections that help connect AIA with the nearly 2,000 individual architects and are involved in the communities in a number of ways. The sections are Architects League of Northern NJ, Central, Jersey Shore, Newark & Suburban, South Jersey and West Jersey.

AIA Newark and Suburban Architects is one of six sections in New Jersey. AIA-NS is a growing section which contains over 530 members and encompasses the counties of Essex, Morris, Union, and Warren.

For over 75 years AIA Newark and Suburban Architects has striven to meet the needs and interests of its members and the public by developing public awareness on the value of architecture and the importance of good design to help improve the built environment.
