The AIA New Jersey Design Awards program celebrates the exceptional work of New Jersey architects and recognizes projects that demonstrate design excellence, innovation, and a commitment to improving the built environment.

Open to projects of all scales, budgets, styles, and building types, the program highlights the diverse range of work created by New Jersey architects and showcases the many ways architecture shapes our communities, enhances daily life, and responds to the evolving needs of society.

Through thoughtful design, collaboration, and a commitment to the values of the profession, these projects exemplify the impact architects have in creating meaningful spaces, strengthening communities, and advancing a more resilient, equitable, and sustainable future.

2026 Tri-State Design Awards Call for Submissions

It is also a **Tristate Design Award Competition year**, providing additional recognition opportunities for outstanding projects across the region. Projects submitted to the **AIA New Jersey Design Awards program between 2023 and 2026** are eligible to be submitted for consideration in the **Tristate Design Awards Competition**, which recognizes design excellence across participating AIA chapters in the region. ELIGIBILITY

A project may be submitted, provided the project and its submitting firm/architect adhere to the following criteria.

SUBMITTING FIRM

The submitting firm must be the Architect of Record* and/or the Design Architect. In the case of multi-office firms, eligible projects are limited to work done primarily by the NJ-based office as the Architect of Record and/or Design Architect.

* The AIA National Ethics Council typically views the Architect of Record as the legal entity that has contracted for and completed the work in question. This entity can be a corporation, partnership, or individual architect.

AIA MEMBERSHIP

The submitting firm, as Architect of Record and/or Design Architect, must have at least one Principal who is a current AIA New Jersey architect member in good standing.

AIA FRAMEWORK FOR DESIGN EXCELLENCE

Each submission will be required to demonstrate how the project meets a minimum of three of the ten defining principles of AIA Framework for Design Excellence. Each project will have up to 750 words to explain a minimum of three design excellence principles incorporated into the project. [Link to AIA Framework for Design Excellence](#).

Criteria 2

In order to be eligible, submissions must comply with at least one of the following items

- An AIA New Jersey member whose practice is located in New Jersey may submit projects from any location.
- An AIA New Jersey member who practices outside of New Jersey may submit projects from any location.
- An AIA member from any state may submit projects located within New Jersey.
- Only AIA and Associate AIA New Jersey members are eligible for the Unbuilt category. "Unbuilt" is defined as competitions or projects that are not intended to be built. If your project wins in this category and at some point, is built, it cannot be submitted for consideration in any other category in the future.

ENTRY FEE

The cost per project entry is \$150 for the first entry and \$100 for each additional category you submit the project in. Please note that your project can only win in one category.

Firms are permitted to enter as many projects as they want.

PROJECT CATEGORIES

All projects submitted must be blind. There will be no mention of the submitting firm, project team members, consultants, clients, or any identifying information within the submission materials.

BUILT PROJECTS

Built Project categories recognize design excellence in various kinds of built architectural projects. Submissions may be a single building, a related group of buildings, interior architecture, additions, restorations, or adaptive use projects. Entries may be eligible in more than one category; however, a separate fee is required for each category submission made, per fee information listed above.

1. Open

Eligibility: Public and private projects: single buildings, a related group of buildings forming a single project, and additions/renovations including but not limited to commercial, institutional, mixed-use, multi-family, and educational projects.

2. Residential Design

Eligibility: Single-family residences, accessory buildings or Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADUs), new or remodeled, or any addition.

3. Preservation

Eligibility: Projects including historic preservation, historic restoration, historic rehabilitation, reconstruction, and/or adaptive reuse.

4. Interior Architecture

Eligibility: projects of any scope that may be new construction, renovation, preservation, restoration, rehabilitation, or reconstruction, that focus on interior space only.

5. Built Sustainability

Eligibility: Recognizes excellence in ecological stewardship, including reduced environmental impact and reduced energy consumption, as well as attention to quality-of-life issues, resiliency, and community engagement within the environment. Must demonstrate adherence to a sustainability standard LEED, Green Globes, Passive house or similar. Ideal projects have also met the AIA Design 2030 Commitment Criteria.

6. Small Project // Object

Object, artwork installation, work of environmental art, furniture etc.

7. Small Project // Under \$500,000

Small project construction, or architectural design under \$500,000 in construction cost.

8. Small Project // Under \$1.5 Million

Small project construction under 1.5 million in construction cost.

9. Small Project // Under 3,000 Square Feet

REGIONAL AND URBAN DESIGN (Built and Unbuilt Projects)

Eligibility: urban design projects, planning programs, civic improvements, campus plans, Master plans, environmental programs or redevelopment projects. Examples might be research, policy development and implementation, community initiatives or charrettes, and input and assessment tools

Projects may be submitted in one of two subcategories:

10. Built Regional and Urban Design Projects

Eligibility: Completed projects that demonstrate the successful implementation of regional or urban design strategies. Eligible work may include built urban design projects, civic improvements, campus plans, redevelopment projects, environmental initiatives, and other realized planning effort

11. Unbuilt Regional and Urban Design Projects

Eligibility: Planning, research, policy, and design initiatives that have not yet been fully implemented but demonstrate a compelling vision for future communities and environments.

AIA New Jersey Design Award Submitter & Project Information

After creating an account and logging in on OpenWater, you may view the entire submission form and save your submission as you work to complete it. You may log back in at any time to finalize your submission before the submission cutoff date. You will not be asked to process payment until your submission is complete.

Please note; all submission materials must be blind including narratives, file names, photo/rendering and plan captions, and all copy/content included in file uploads. Please double-check your materials. Submissions whose materials indicate a firm affiliation will be disqualified.

THE JURY

Each year, the AIA New Jersey Design Award Committee assembles a jury of distinguished architects selected for their breadth of experience, commitment to design excellence, and unique perspectives on architectural practice. Jury members are invited based on their leadership and contributions to the profession, ensuring a range of voices and viewpoints.

The jury is intentionally composed of professionals from outside the AIA New Jersey region, allowing for an independent and unbiased review of submissions. This external perspective helps ensure that projects are evaluated solely on the strength of their design quality, innovation, and impact.

DESIGN AWARD HONORS

The jury will have sole discretion to determine whether to select a recipient for an award and how many awards to present. All projects that reach the final round of jurying will be considered for the following awards.

HONOR AWARD

May be granted, at the jury's discretion to projects that exemplify distinguished achievement in any category.

MERIT AWARD

May be granted, at the jury's discretion to any project that either lies outside of the other categories or bears an exceptional aspect that the jury feels represents excellence which deserves recognition.
